

**Do I need to submit anything with my artwork?**

You may if you wish. A title if one exists and a short accompanying written statement would be fine. Please ensure that your work is clearly marked with your name.

**When does the image need to be submitted?**

Please get the artwork to the church hall on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> between 12-8pm. Please ring if these times are not suitable.

**Can I sell my image at the exhibition?**

Yes you can if you choose to. We would ask for 10% of anything you sell as a donation to our local charity. Please ensure that you clearly price your work and include a contact telephone number so possible purchasers can contact you.

**When will I get my artwork back?**

Artwork *must* be collected by the artist immediately after the Kingshill Art Festival (4pm on the Sunday)

**We reserve the right to not display submitted art for the exhibition. All Artwork is submitted at artists' own risk.**

## **Guidelines for Submissions of Art Work**

### **What can you submit?**

Artwork can include any drawn, painted, photographic, printed processes, sewn/embroidered/fabric, flower/vegetable arrangements, 3-dimensional pieces, figurative, non-figurative...pretty much anything goes, but check out if you are not sure.

### **What does it cost to submit artwork for the exhibition?**

Nothing

### **How much space am I allocated?**

It depends on what you are submitting but the following will be available to use upon request:

1 x wall/board space and/or 1 x table (6'x 3')

### **Can I submit more than one piece of artwork?**

Yes, as long as they fit within the allocated space

### **Do images need to be framed?**

No. Please note that if the image is to be hung it will need to have all the fittings in place to do so. If a 3-D piece needs a stand, please provide this.

### **Can I display my own work?**

Yes although we are happy to do this for you.

### **When do I need to inform you if I am submitting a piece of work?**

Preferably by early September. Later submissions may still be possible. **However, PLEASE RING or e-mail a.s.a.p to inform us that you wish to participate.**
